

# CERTIFICATE COURSE IN HEALTH PROJECT MANAGEMENT, SIFPSA, Lucknow

## Purpose

The success of any health programme depends on investment in capacity building of human resources in terms of strengthening their skills for better program planning, management and implementation. At the same time in light of several health programmes being implemented and NGOs having role in supporting these programmes at community level it is all the more important for NGOs to update and gear-up skills and knowledge of these managers.

This course provides NGO managers an opportunity to advance their abilities in the field of management of health and family welfare programmes, facilitation and strategic planning by exploring a broad array of topics geared to assist participants in identifying their leadership and managerial styles as well as in addressing concrete skills to enhance their effectiveness as health managers.

## Objectives

- To **enhance the skills** and leadership ability in the area of health programme management

- To **equip with managerial tools** that would lead them towards a better management of health programmes
- To **provide latest update** on current community health programmes in the State of UP.

## Participants

The course is designed for Non - Governmental Organization top and mid level managers working in health and development sector

## Eligibility

The Health programme management certificate course is designed for NGO Programme Managers/ health functionaries who work in health programmes at community, block, district, state levels. Participants with a commitment to build leadership in health programme and who meet the following essential criteria will be considered:

- Candidate must have graduation degree in any discipline.
- A minimum of 3-5 years experience working in RCH program management and/or implementation

Preference would be given to the candidates having--

- Demonstrated commitment to health programme planning, management or implementation that positively impacts community,
- Demonstrated motivation or ability to bring about change at the community, block, district or state level.

- Candidates working within the state of U.P.

## Medium of Training

The course will be conducted in mixed language in Hindi and English and selected applicants must be highly proficient in written and spoken Hindi with good understanding of English.

## Course Duration

Two weeks which includes class room teaching and group discussions scheduled from Monday to Saturday including 2 days field exposure.

## Course Outline

The course content includes-

- **Leadership skills**—identify and strengthen personal and professional leadership traits to design and implement institutional and community programmes,
- **Program Management**—Effective Programme planning, team building, develop and apply techniques and tools for effective program management,
- **Financial Management**—budgeting, planning, financial record keeping
- **Communication**—understands and applies strategic communication techniques to educate, motivate, and mobilize communities, decision makers, and institutions for change, skills on IPC, BCC techniques.

- Latest update knowledge on schemes planned and operational under National Rural Health Mission, technical knowledge on maternal health, neo-natal health, adolescent health, family planning and role of NGO functionaries under these programmes.

### Training Methods

The course would be taught by programme and management experts. Teaching methods would include lectures supported by presentations, discussions, group work, exercises, practical training through field visits etc.

### Fees

The course fee is subsidized upto 70% by SIFPSA. Participant have to pay 30% of the course fee i.e. Rs. 3750/- for 2 weeks programme. The fee can be paid by sponsoring institutions and NGOs.

### Accommodation

Upon acceptance to the program, SIFPSA will make arrangement of stay in hotel and training venue will be at SIFPSA, Vishal Complex, 19 A, V.S. Marg, Lucknow.
