

10. Referral Linkages

10.1 Referral from home to facility-State level




Across all health facilities of the State, mode of transport reported has been largely 'government' with negligible (CHC & DWH-9%) or nil use of private transport. Referrals reported by BMCs and DCH have been quite low.


Referral from home to facility-Division wise

As per the graph, 100 percent FRUs in Basti, Jhansi and Saharanpur divisions have reported referrals with mode of transport as 'government'. However, about 67% of the facilities in Basti division have also reported 'private' vehicle as the mode of transport to the facility.

In 75 districts all block units including First Refferal Units "108" ambulance is bringing patients from home to nearest facility on call basis. In the month of September 2013 total 1,17,834 ANC brought from home to nearest health facility for Delivery. A total of 1,71,868 patients received home to health facility service through "108" ambulance.



10.2 Referral from Inter facility-State level




Eighty percent of the medical colleges, followed by almost 63 percent of the BMCs and 58 percent of the CHCs have reported inter-facility referrals with 'government' vehicle as the mode of transport.


Referral from Inter facility-Division wise

Inter facility referrals have been reported by hundred percent of the facilities in Basti and Saharanpur divisions followed by Moradabad (86%) and Jhansi (83%). Only 21 percent of the facilities in Varanasi division and 30 percent in Agra have reported inter-facility referrals. In all cases, government vehicle has been reported as the mode of transport.

In all 75 districts referral to Inter facility service within district to patients through "108" is 11430 cases and 818 referral cases out of district for treatment in the month of September 2013. In First Referrals Units state ambulance is also available for referral to higher institutions.



10.3 Drop back facility-State level




Almost all the facilities in the State have reported drop back service, with hundred percent reporting 'government' vehicle as the mode of transport.

Drop back facility-Division wise

Drop back services have been reported by hundred percent of the facilities in Aligarh, Basti, Jhansi, Moradabad and Saharanpur divisions closely followed by Kanpur Nagar, Agra, Bareilly, Faizabad and Lucknow divisions. Only government vehicle has been reported as the mode of transport.

In all 75 districts under Janani Suraksha Karyakaram two types of vehicles were provided to all health Units specially First Refferals Units. One is Taxi permit vehicle for drop back service from hospital to home. Second One is state ambulance available at each health unit.



Right now both the vehicles were used for drop back facility to patients (Delivery) free of cost. In the month of September 2013 a total of 3,92,572 beneficiary of delivery services were dropped from facility to home.
