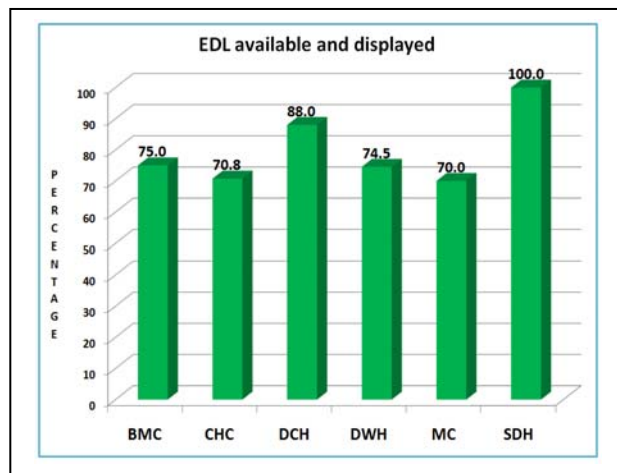

7. Essential Drugs and Supplies

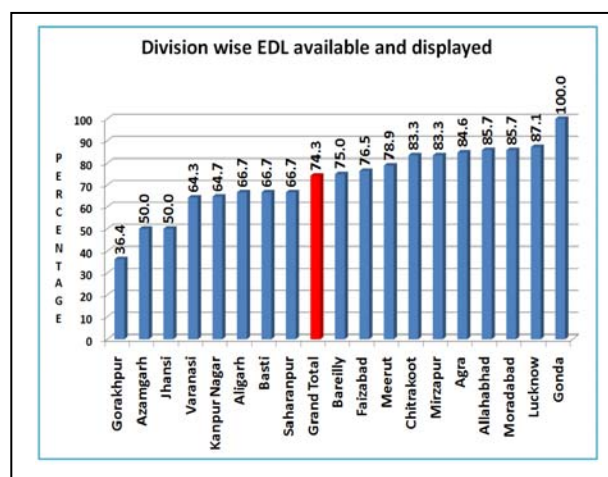
7.1 EDL available and displayed- State level



Availability and prominent display of essential drug list (EDL) are important means to ensure all required/ essential drugs are available at the FRU. The EDL was found to be displayed at 100 percent SDHs, while over a fourth of BMCs, CHCs, DWHs and MCs either did not have the EDL or did not display it.

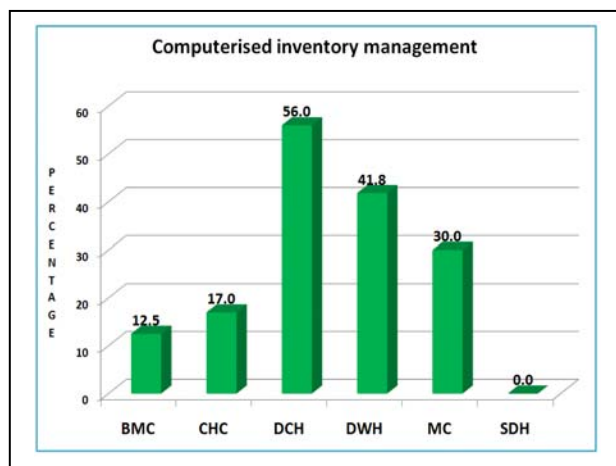
EDL available and displayed- Division wise

Division wise analysis of availability and display of essential drug list (EDL) shows that one in every four facilities in the state did not comply with the instructions of displaying the EDL prominently. Gonda on the other hand was the only division with 100 percent compliance. Gorakhpur (36%) followed by Azamgarh (50%) and Jhansi (50%) were at the bottom of the chart.

7.2 Computerized Inventory management- State level



The graph portrays a grim picture of use of computerized inventory management, an important management tool for overall supply chain management in Uttar Pradesh. Only 56 percent of DCHs, 41 percent of DWHs and a very small number of CHCs and BMCs were found to be accessing/using the computerized inventory management. None of the SDHs was found to be accessing it.

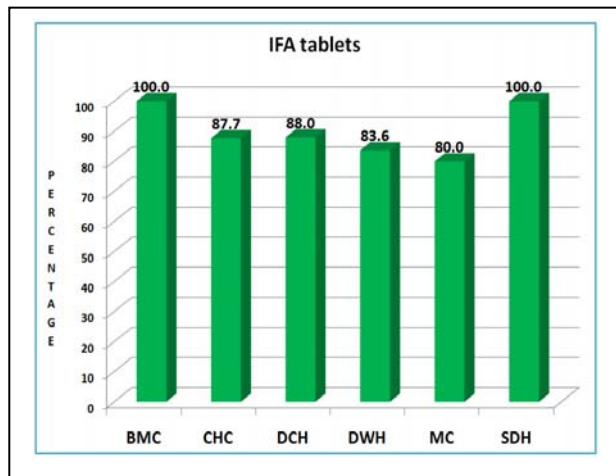
Division wise-

The overall situation of computerized inventory management in the state needs major improvement with little over one fourth facilities in the state doing it. Aligarh division presents the best picture with one in every two facilities having access to and using computerized inventory management while Basti and Jhansi have none.

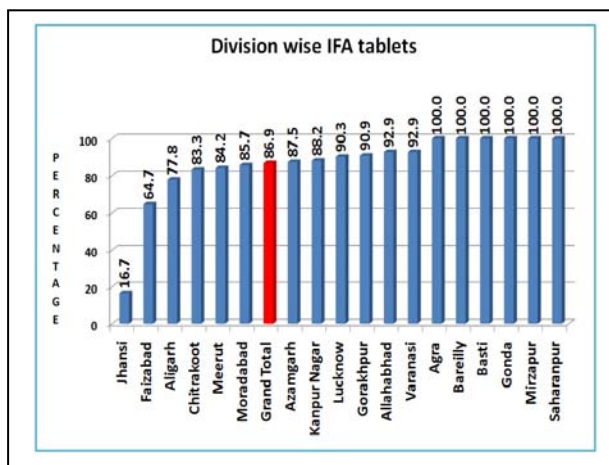
7.3 IFA Tablets- State level



Availability and access to adequate quantity of IFA tablets is critical for managing high level of anemia prevalent in the state, particularly among pregnant women and adolescent girls. SDHs and BMCs are the only facilities ensuring 100 percent availability of IFA tablets while at all other facilities the percentage available was in eighties.

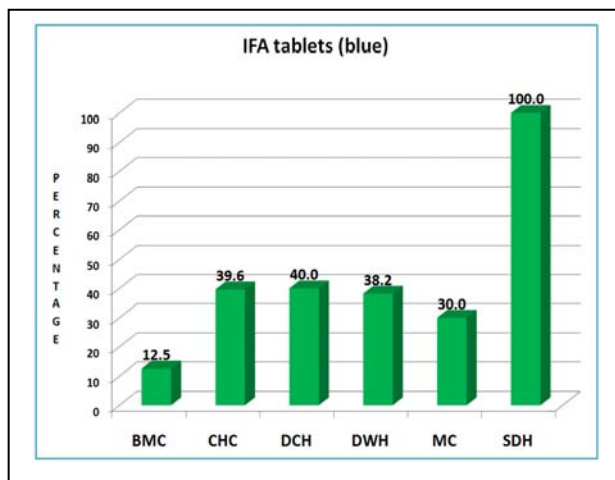
Division wise-

The graph shows the division wise availability and access to IFA tablets. On average 13 percent facilities in the state reported stock out of IFA tablets at the time of survey, while there were 6 divisions where the availability was 100 percent. Jhansi division was an exception with more than 83 percent of its facilities not having IFA stock available which is alarming.

7.4 IFA tablets (blue) - State level

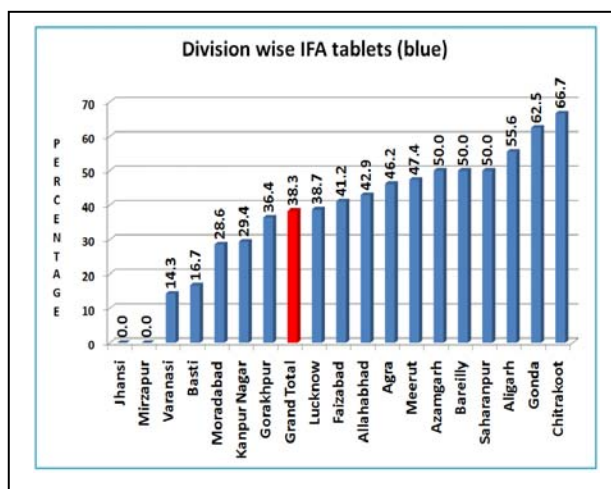


Availability of blue IFA tablets shows all SDH facilities had the same available while all other facilities had much less. Only 13 percent of the BMCs reported having blue IFA tablets in their stock.

Division wise-

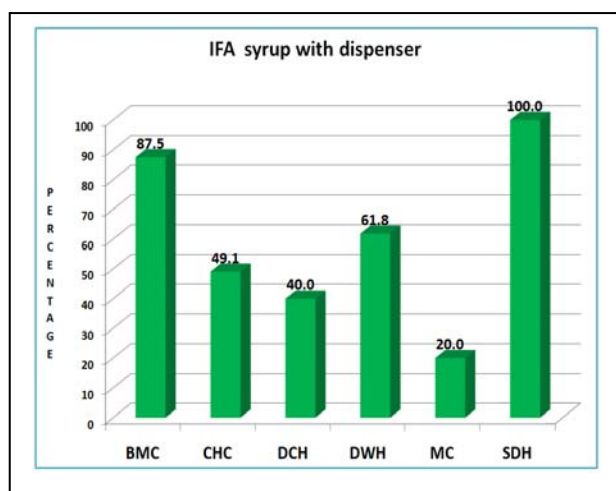
Division wise availability of blue IFA tablets shows that little over one third FRUs had the same available. None of the divisions have reported more than two third of facilities with Blue IFA supply. Jhansi and Mirzapur divisions have reported complete stock-out of the same at all of their facilities.

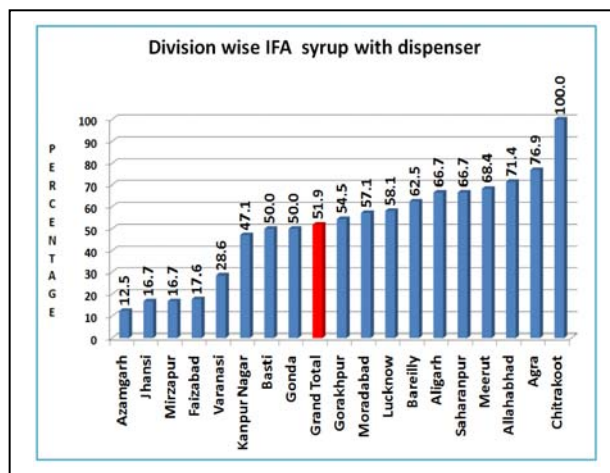
7.5 IFA syrup with dispenser - State level



The availability of IFA syrup with dispenser shows 100 percent SDH facilities have it in their stock, followed by BMC (88%). Only 20 percent medical colleges had IFA syrup with dispenser and less than 50 percent CHCs and DCHs have reported availability of the same.

Division wise-

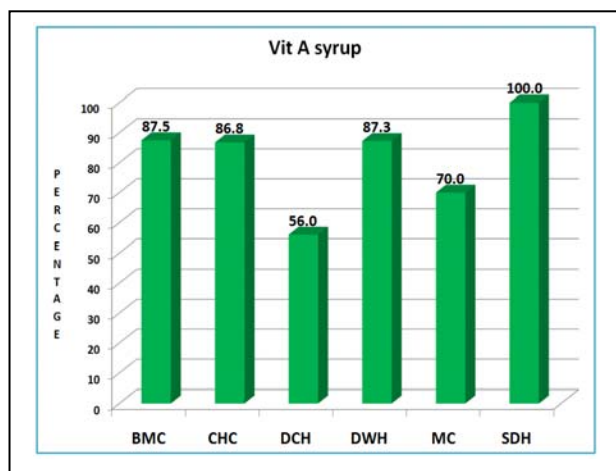
The divisional analysis shows a little over half of the facilities in the state have reported the availability of IFA syrup with dispenser. Chitrakoot was the only division with 100 percent availability at all its facilities, while Azamgarh, Jhansi, Mirzapur and Faizabad divisions had less than 20 percent facilities reporting stock availability of IFA syrup with dispenser.

7.6 Vitamin A syrup - State level

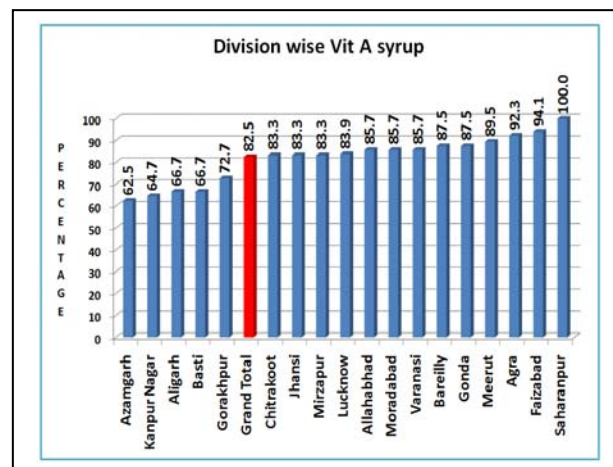


Vitamin-A syrup is an important drug supplement for the growth and wellbeing of a child. 100 percent SDHs have reported availability of the Vit A syrup while DCH on the other hand had 44 percent facilities reporting stock out of Vit A syrup.

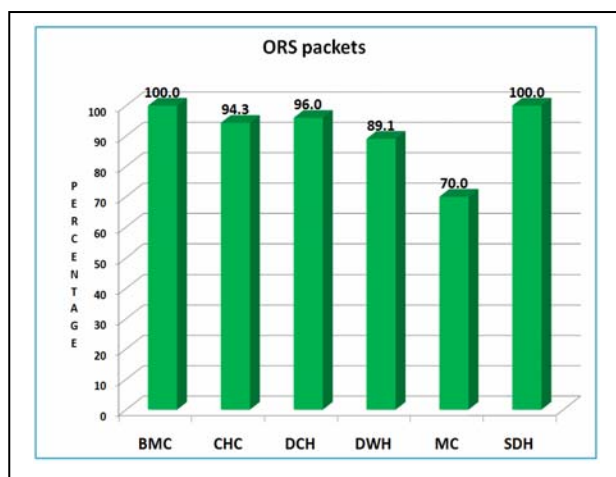

7.7 ORS Packets - Sate level

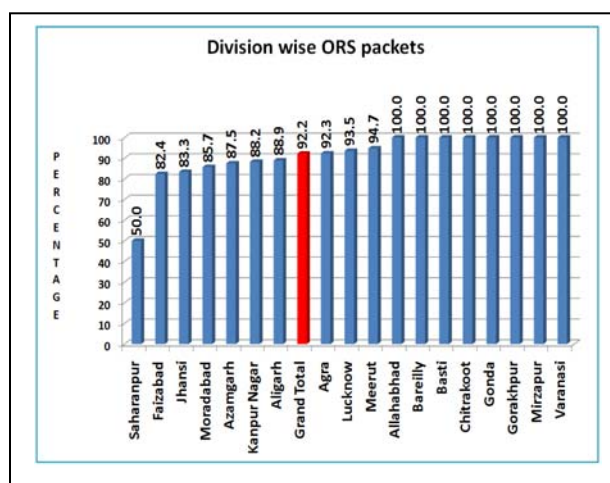


ORS was found to be universally available across all facilities with some stock-out reported by medical colleges (30%), DWH (11%), CHC (6%) and DCH (4%).

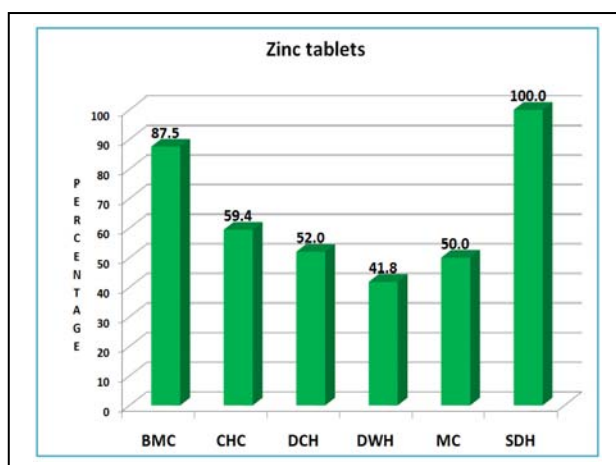
Division wise-

Divisional analysis on availability of ORS packets shows that on an average 92 percent facilities had ORS, with 8 divisions having 100 percent supply. Saharanpur division was an exception with only one in every two facilities having ORS supply.

7.8 Zinc Tablets - State level

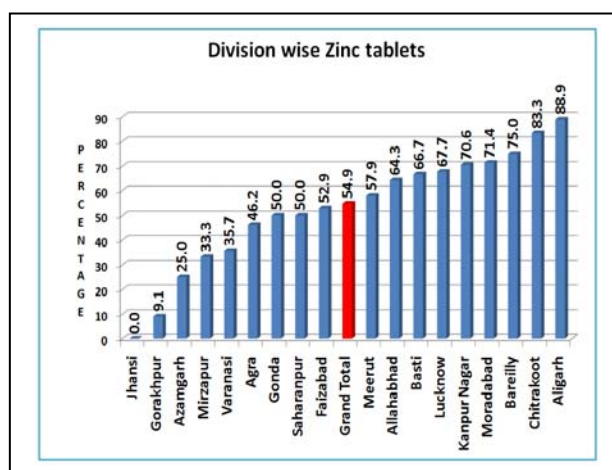


Zinc tablet is an important drug for effective control of diarrheal diseases. While the SDHs have ensured 100 percent availability of zinc tablets, 50 percent of the medical colleges did not have zinc tablets in their stock.

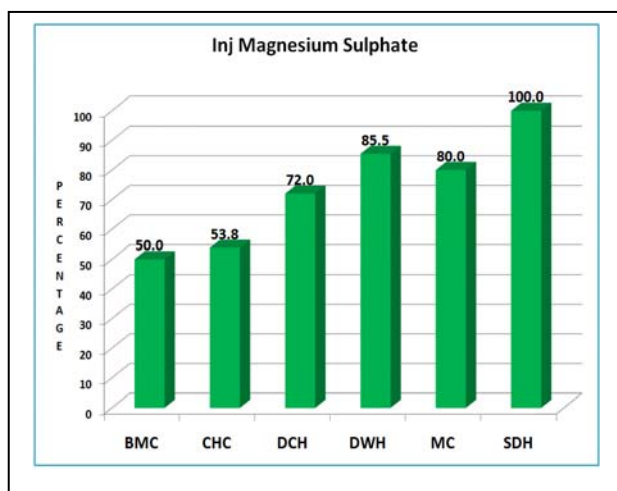
Division wise-

The divisional analysis of the availability of zinc tablets shows little over half (55%) of the facilities having it in their stock. None of the facilities in Jhansi division had stock of zinc tablets followed by Gorakhpur division where over 90 percent facilities reported stock-out.

7.9 Injection Magnesium sulphate - State level

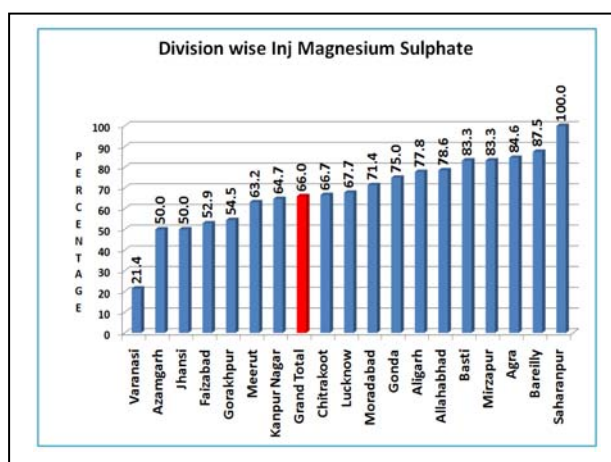


Ensuring availability of injection magnesium sulphate is critical in the management of labour and PPH. All SDH facilities reported availability of mag-sulph injection while one in every two BMCs reported stock out of the same followed by 46 percent of CHCs and 28 percent DCHs.

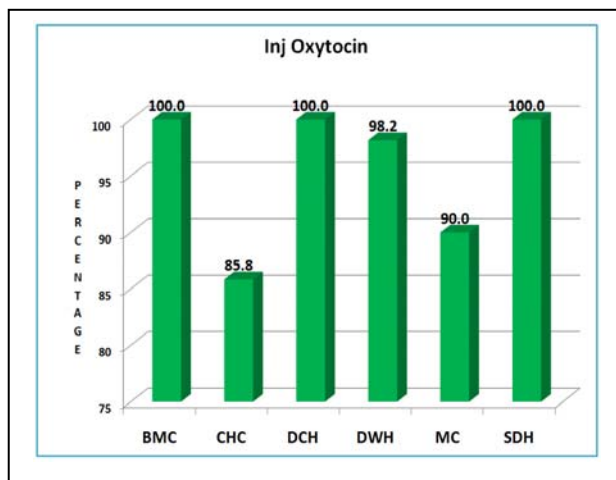
Division wise-

7.10 Injection Oxytocin - State level

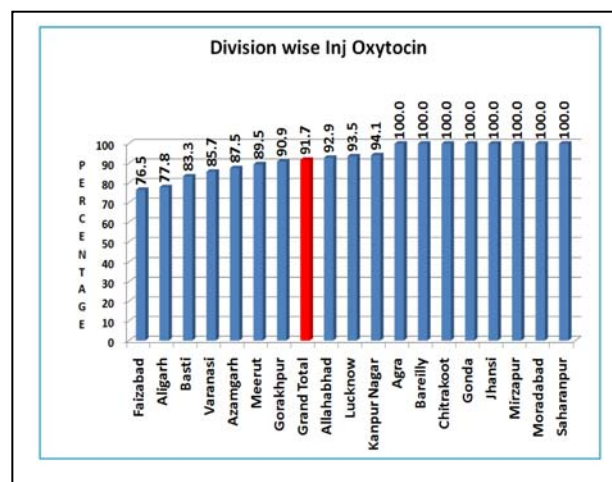


Injection oxytocin is another critical lifesaving drug used in safe delivery care services and its availability across facilities shows a mixed picture with BMCs, DCH and SDHs reporting 100 percent availability. About 14 percent CHCs on the other had reported stock out of the same. Surprisingly 10 percent medical colleges too have reported stock out.

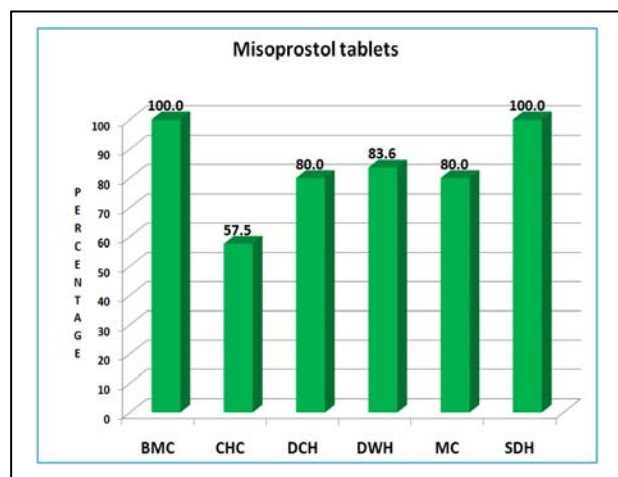
Division wise-

Divisional analysis of the availability of oxytocin injection shows as almost 92 percent facilities in the state having its availability with about 8 divisions reporting 100 percent availability.

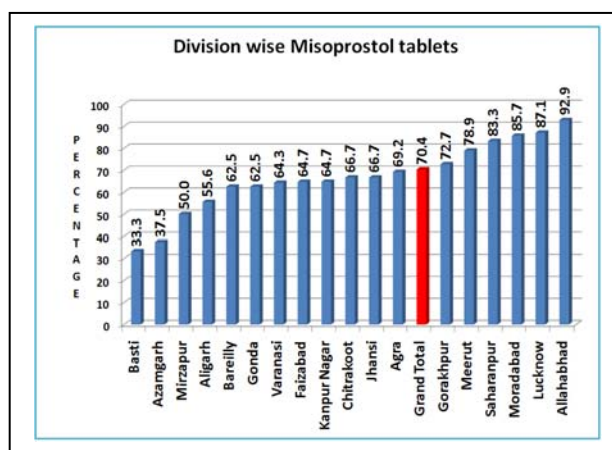
7.11 Misoprostol Tablets - State level



Tablet misoprostol is another critical lifesaving drug in safe delivery care specifically in managing PPH. The BMCs and SDHs have ensured this was available at all their facilities while about 46 percent CHCs reported stock out of misoprostol tablets.

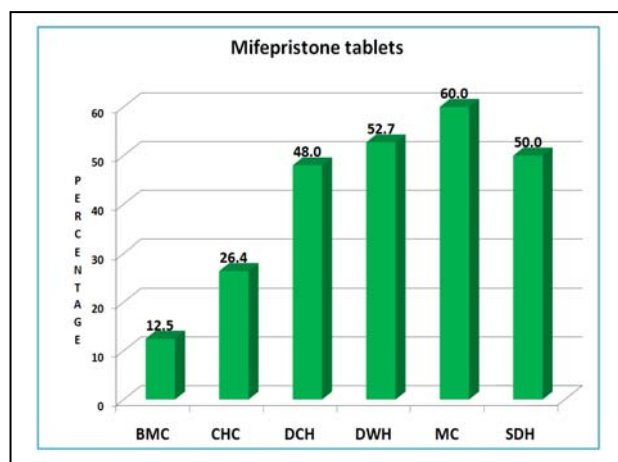
Division wise-

On average 30 percent FRUs in the state reported stock out of Misoprostol tables- a lifesaving drug in managing PPH/ safe delivery care. Huge inter-divisional variation reported in stock status of misoprostol tables in the state with Basti at its lowest with two third facilities reporting stock out. Allahabad division had 93 percent facilities maintaining the stock of misoprostol.

7.12 Mifepristone tablets - State level

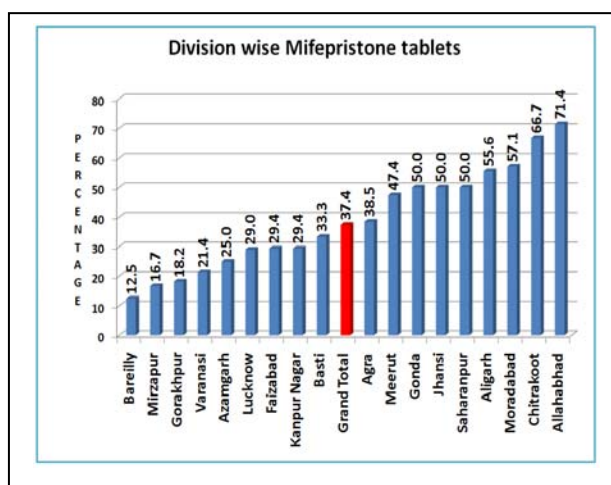


The availability of mifepristone tablets was highest in medical colleges (60%) followed by DWH (52%) and SDH (50%). Only 13 percent BMCs had mifepristone tablets in their stock.

Division wise-

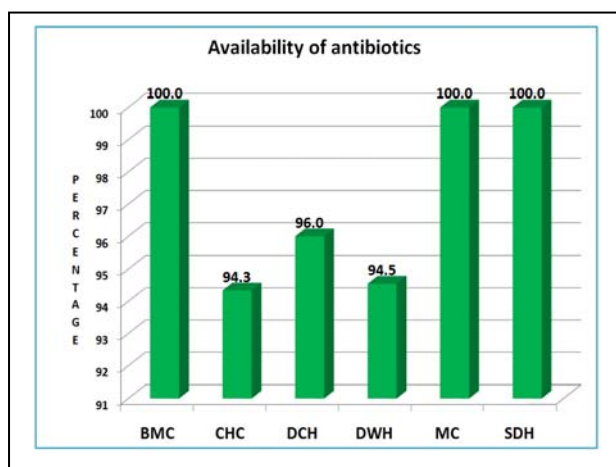
Little over one third FRUs were found to be having mifepristone tablets in their stock with huge inter divisional variation reported. Bareilly had only 13 percent facilities maintaining the stock while Allahabad had 71 percent facilities reporting availability of this drug.

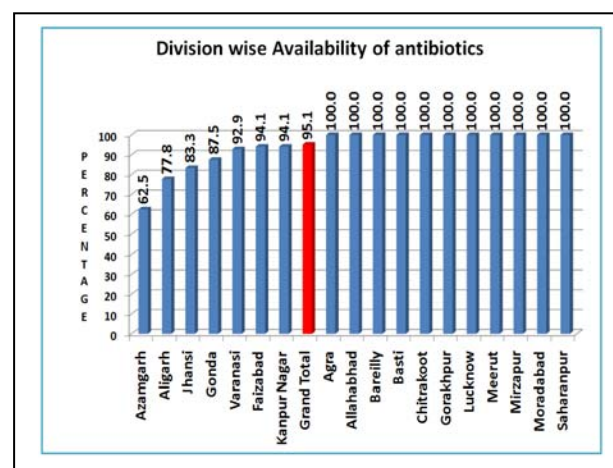

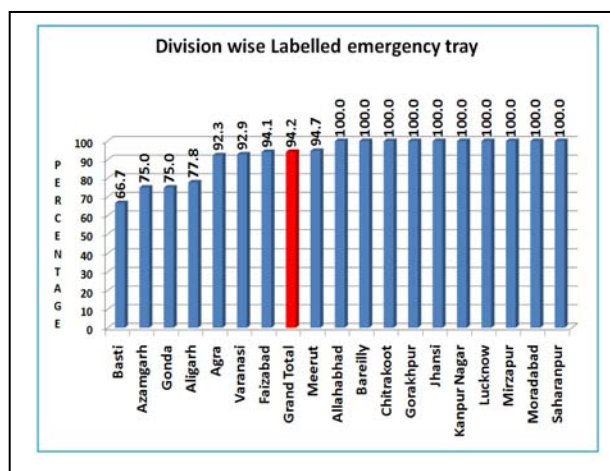

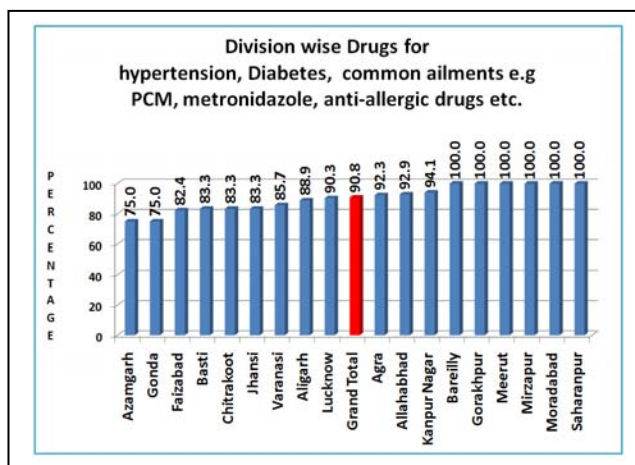

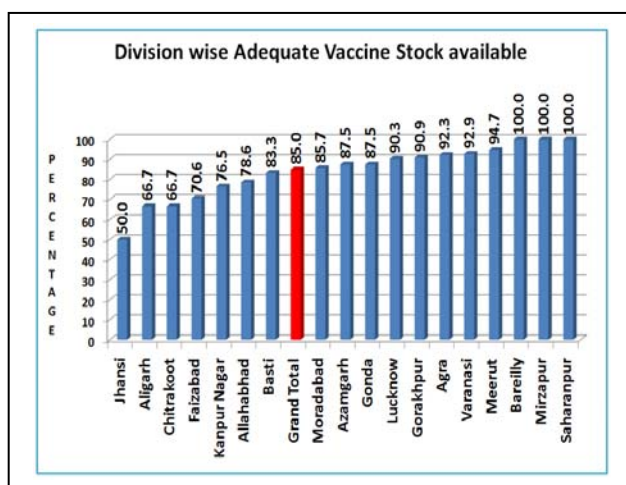


Ensuring availability of adequate stock of all essential vaccines as per the National UIP norms is an important preventive care measure against several avoidable diseases. 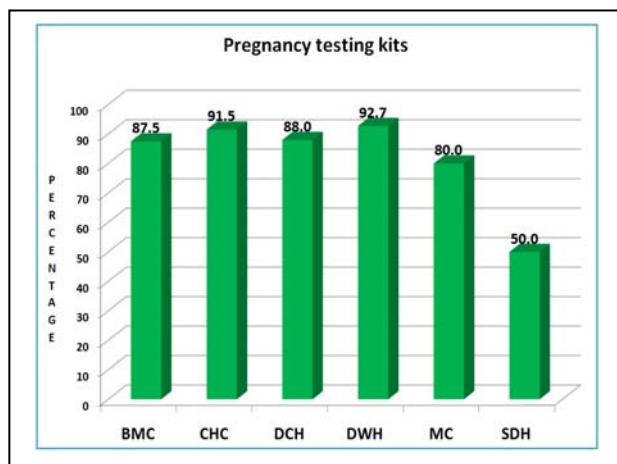

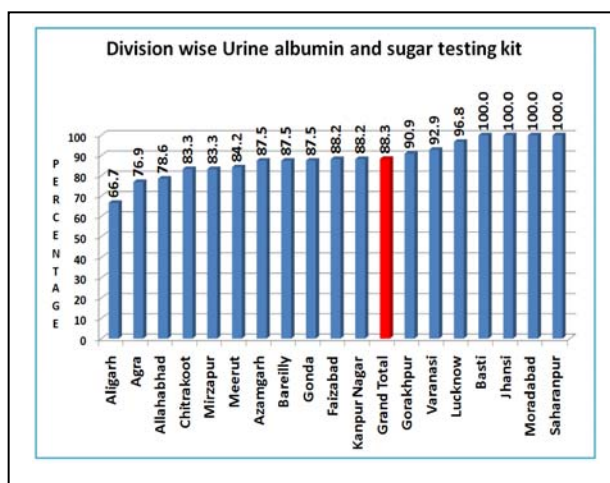

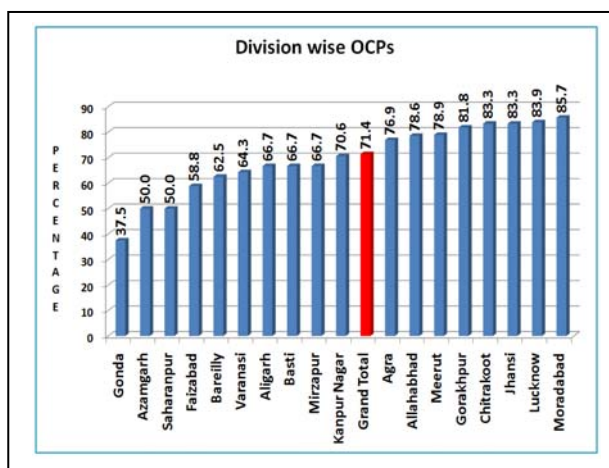
7.19 Oral contraceptive Pills - State

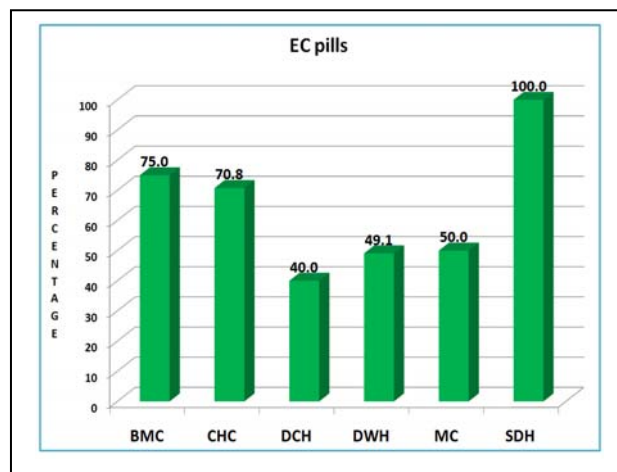

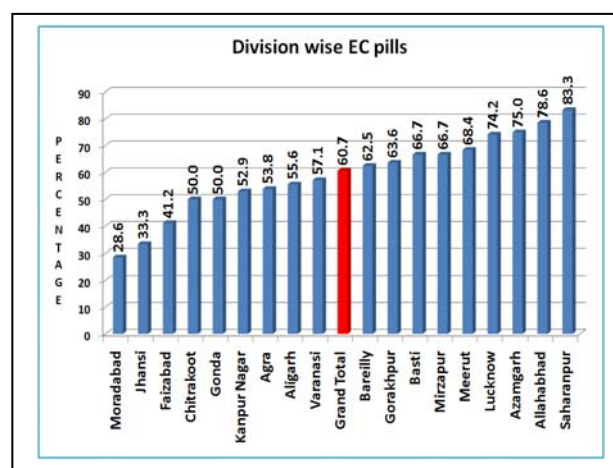
7.20 Emergency Contraceptive Pills - State level



Hundred percent of the sub-divisional hospitals, seventy five percent of the BMCs and seventy one percent of the CHCs were found to be stocking emergency contraceptive pills. However, a large number of district community hospitals (three fifths) and almost half of the district women's hospitals in the state had a stock-out of the ECPs.

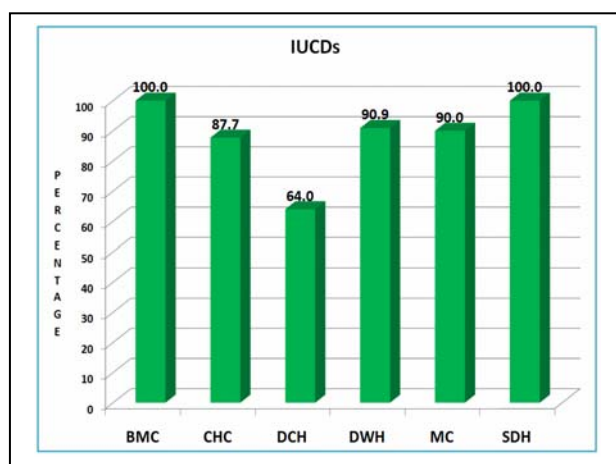
